### How to label a keyboard

Use the following picture to help you. You will notice that there is more than one of each note (four F keys for example). This is why we use different colours in school so that the tunes are played in the correct octave. Some keyboards will not have C as the lowest (far left) key. If this is the case, use the pattern of black and white notes to help you work out where each C is and then the picture below to label the other keys.
