Boys

Mid grey/black school trousers
Mid grey/black tailored shorts for Summer only

Navy blue round neck jumpers
(plain or with logo)
White shirts/polo shirts
(plain or with logo)

Girls

Mid grey/black skirts (no slits), of a reasonable length
Mid grey/black trousers
Mid grey/black tailored shorts for Summer only

Navy blue round neck jumpers/cardigans
(plain or with logo)
White blouses/polo shirts
(plain or with logo)
Blue/white or gold/white small check dresses for Summer only
Headscarves in Navy blue, black or white
NB – head wear generally (bands etc) should also be navy blue, black or white

Footwear

Sensible black shoes **must** be worn during class lesson times.
Trainers should **only** be worn for P.E. and games.
High-heeled shoes are unsafe in school.
Boots should only be worn to and from school with a pair of shoes to change into.
In summer term girls may wear black or white sensible sandals.

All clothing, school bags and equipment must be labelled with your child's name
Please only provide a small school bag as there is limited space in the lockers. Pupils in KS1 should use a book bag instead of a school bag.

Long hair should be tied back please and hair styles should be smart and not cause a distraction.
Jewellery should not be worn with the exception of one watch and no more than one plain stud per ear which must be removed or covered for PE. Make up, including nail varnish, should not be worn.
